following
O R D E R**

1. Petitioner challenges the judgment and order dated 13-12-2024 in C.R.M. (NDPS) No.1929/2024 passed by the High Court at Calcutta, titled "Asraful @ Bali @ Asraful Ali vs. The State of West Bengal".

2. The petitioner was arrested in connection with Crime No.204 of 2021 registered at Goalpokher Police Station, Islampur Sub-Division, Uttar Dinajpur District, West Bengal for the offences punishable under Sections 14(b) & 14(c) of the Foreigners Act, 1946, read with Section 21(c) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

3. Having heard learned counsel for the parties, and perused the material placed on record, we are of the considered view that the petitioner has made out case for interference with the impugned order dated 13-12-2024.

4. Considering the totality of

circumstances and also the fact that the petitioner was in custody since 20.03.2024, we are inclined to grant bail to the petitioner on such terms as may be fixed by the Trial Court. Ordered accordingly.

5. To comply with the order, the petitioner shall be produced before the Trial Court forthwith.

6. Accordingly, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of.

7. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
