

possession. The revision was, therefore, dismissed with costs of Rs.1 lakh.

Heard Mr. Ashish Pandey, learned advocate in support of the petition.

It was put to the learned counsel that the order of imposition of costs would be set aside, if the possession of the property was handed over peacefully within seven days from today.

Learned counsel after taking appropriate instructions has reported his inability to agree to the suggestion.

The SLP is therefore, dismissed confirming the order of costs.

Considering the facts and circumstances on record, the trial court is directed to conclude the proceedings as early as possible and preferably within three months from the receipt of copy of this order. The trial court shall also insist on payment of costs by the petitioners.

The Registry shall send copy of this order to the concerned trial court for facility and compliance.

Pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
