We have perused the order impugned in this
appeal. The Trial Court convicted the
respondent for the offences under Section 304-A
of IPC and sentenced to undergo rigorous
imprisonment for a period of six months and
fine of Rs.400/- with usual default sentence.
The High Court while enhancing the fine amount
from Rs.400/- to Rs.1,000/-, without assigning
any reason and without any justifiable ground,
modified the period of imprisonment to the
period already undergone, which was only ten
days.

In such circumstances, we are convinced
that this order is liable to be set aside.
While setting aside the impugned order, the
matter is remitted back to the learned Judge to
decide the Criminal Revision No.256/2012 on
