1. On the last date of hearing, the matter was adjourned to enable the parties to try and resolve their disputes. Today, three drafts (i) ₹1,00,00,000/- (Rupees One crore only) dated 18<sup>th</sup> April, 2024 bearing No.528675; (ii) ₹1,00,00,000/- (Rupees One crore only) dated 18<sup>th</sup> April, 2024 bearing No.528676; and (iii) ₹66,04,914/- (Rupees Sixty six lakhs four thousand nine hundred fourteen only) dated 18<sup>th</sup> April, 2024 bearing No.528677, totaling to a sum of ₹2,66,04,914/- (Rupees Two crores sixty six lakhs four thousand nine hundred fourteen only), towards satisfaction of the decretal amount less TDS for a sum of ₹13,29,073/- (Rupees Thirteen lakhs twenty nine thousand and seventy three only) have been produced by learned counsel for the appellant. It

is submitted that the TDS amount shall be deposited with the Department within four weeks from today and TDS Certificate shall be handed over to the other side within two weeks thereafter.

2. The drafts in question are handed over to learned counsel for the respondent, who states on instructions from his client who is present in Court, that on receiving the aforesaid amount and the TDS certificate, he shall not be left with any right, title or interest in the subject unit located in SKYON project at Gurugam, of the appellant.

3. The appellant and the respondent are bound down by the statement made hereinabove.

4. The present application is disposed of.
