Contempt Petition (Civil) No 821 of 2023

- 1 Ms Garima Prasad, Additional Advocate General appearing on behalf of the State of Uttar Pradesh states that release orders in respect of the three petitioners, namely, Kutai @ Dilip Chandra (Petitioner No 1), Kunwar Bahadur (Petitioner No 2) and Brijesh (Petitioner No 4) have been passed today.
- 2 As regards Swami Nath @ Swami Dayal (Petitioner No 3), it has been stated that the plea for premature release has been rejected by an order passed today.
- 3 The petitioner who has not been granted release would be at liberty to pursue his remedies in accordance with law.
- 4 The Contempt Petition is, hence, disposed of.
- 5 Pending applications, if any, stand dispose of.

6 Ms Garima Prasad, Additional Advocate General appearing on behalf of the State of Uttar Pradesh states that release orders have been passed in respect of the following petitioners, namely :

- (i) Dinesh son of Ram Aasare (Petitioner No 1);
- (ii) Pappu son of Late Shri Ram Kumar Tiwari (Petitioner No 2); and
- (ii) Lallan son of Mahadev (Petitioner No 3).

7 The Additional Advocate General states that the plea for early release of the fourth petitioner (Manoj son of Ved Singh) has been rejected by an order passed today. As regards fifth petitioner (Vaibhav Jain son of Upendra Kumar Jain), it has been stated that an order would be passed after due consideration in accordance with law within a period of two weeks.

8 The petitioner who has not been granted release would be at liberty to pursue his remedies in accordance with law.

9 The Contempt Petition is accordingly disposed of.

10 Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
