UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. This is a petition seeking anticipatory bail
2. Mr. Nishant Ramakantrao Katneshwarkar, learned counsel

appearing for the respondent No.3 vehemently opposes the petition.

3. However, taking into consideration the fact that the interim protection was in operation before the application was rejected by the learned Judge of the High Court for 11 months, we are inclined to issue notice, returnable in four weeks.

4. Dasti, in addition, is permitted.

5. In addition to the usual mode, liberty is granted to the petitioner to serve notice through the Standing Counsel for the respondent/State.

6. By way of an ad interim order, in the event of arrest petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with FIR No. 41 of 2023 registered at Police Station Mondha, District Parbhani, subject to him executing personal bonds for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only), with one or more sureties in the like amount.

7. However, the petitioner is directed to report to the concerned Police Station every Monday and Thursday of every week and as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Officer.
