Heard Mr. S.P. Chaly, learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioner.

2. The counsel would submit that acquittal of the delinquent was a clean one and therefore this should have an implication in the disciplinary proceeding for the delinquent.

3. However, we have considered the history of this litigation and the fact that irregularities were noticed by the learned

Trial court. No doubt the acquittal order was passed in favour of the delinquent. But this by itself would not, in our opinion, alter the decision to take the disciplinary action against the bank employee. The Special Leave Petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
