O R D E R

Leave granted.

During the pendency of this appeal arising from the order dated 24.02.2023, the parties were referred to mediation. We note, recognize and comment the effort put in by the learned mediator Hon'ble Mr. Justice Kurian Joseph, former judge of this Court in resolving the issues between the parties. A Memorandum of Settlement dated 15.05.2023 has been entered into between the parties. The parties also acknowledge that they have subscribed their signatures to the Memorandum of Settlement and stand by the terms agreed therein. A perusal of the Memorandum of Settlement would indicate that the parties have also agreed that their marriage dated 19.02.2011 be dissolved and the various litigations pending between them be quashed and also be closed.

In that view, we direct that the following matters pending before the respective courts shall stand quashed:

1 Complaint u/s 498A, 406, 506,377 and 120B IPC filed by Piyush Vijay Kumar Chopra at PS: Chunabhatti, district Mumbai Suburban, Maharashtra.

2 Complaint No. 6000005/2023 filed u/s 156(3) of the Cr.P.C. alleging offences u/s 354A, 500 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and u/s 66A, 67, 67A of the Information and Technology Act, 2000 before the 60<sup>th</sup> Court, Metropolitan Magistrate, Kurla, District Mumbai Suburban, Maharashtra.

3 FIR No. 93/2022 (subsequently renumbered as C.R. NO.62/2022) u/s 354A, 500 IPC and Sections 66A, 67 & 67A of the IT Act on the file of P.S. Chunabhatti leading to registration of PW Case No. 1751/PW/2022 and pending before the 60<sup>th</sup> Court of the Ld. Metropolitan Magistrate, Kurla, Mumbai.

4 Complaint dated 26<sup>th</sup> April, 2022 filed by Smt. Vinod Chopra mother of Piyush Chopra u/s 354A, 500 IPC and Sections 66A, 67 & 67A of the IT Act before the Chunabhatti Police Station, District Mumbai Suburban, Maharashtra.

5 Complaints filed by Piyush Chopra before the Chunabhatti police station dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August, 2022 and 8<sup>th</sup> August, 2022(FIR yet to be registered)

6 Complaint dated 13.06.2021 filed by Rohan Khanna in Wadala TT Police Station, District Mumbai Suburban, Maharashtra.

7 Complaint dated 13.11.2021 filed by Rohan Khanna in BKC Police Station, District Mumbai Suburban, Maharashtra.

8 Private Complaint bearing No. "SS cases W/2900001/2023" titled "Rohan Khanna Vs. Piyush Chopra" filed before the Metropolitan Magistrate, Bhoiwada, Dadar, Mumbai, Maharashtra."

Insofar as the civil litigations involving the Contempt Petition bearing Civil M.A.No. 191/2022 titled 'Rohan Pramod Kumar Khanna Vs. Piyush Vijay Kumar Chopra" pending before the Family Court at Bandra, Maharashtra between the parties, this order shall be produced and the matters shall be closed as per the Settlement reached between the parties. In that view, in exercise of our power under Article 142 of the Constitution of India, we hereby hold and declare that the marriage dated 19.02.2011 contracted between the parties shall stand dissolved. Decree shall be drawn in that regard.

The memorandum of Settlement dated 15.05.2023 is made a part of this order.

The appeal is disposed of in the above terms.
