O R D E R

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and having perused the material placed on record, we are not inclined to consider interference in the order dated 18.02.2022 as passed by the High Court of Judicature at Bombay, Bench at Aurangabad in Criminal Writ Petition No. 1224 of 2020, essentially for the reason that in the said order, the High Court has not decided any issue or any question at all; rather has only recorded the statement made by

the APP on the basis of the instructions received about registration of Crime No. 121 of 2022 at Kotwali Police Station, Ahmednagar and, thereafter, had disposed of the petition.

As regards any grievance sought to be raised by the petitioner concerning registration of the said FIR or any other related issue, we are clearly of the view that when the petitioner was not even a party before the High Court and when the High Court has also not adjudicated on any point and has not issued any writ, order or direction against the petitioner, the petitioner may take recourse to appropriate remedies, ofcourse in accordance with law.

That being the position, permission to file this petition as also prayer for granting leave in this matter is declined.

The petition is dismissed, subject to the observations foregoing.

All pending applications also stand disposed of.
