Considering the fact that the petitioners were acquitted by the competent Criminal Court by giving benefit of doubt and even in the disciplinary proceedings they were held to be guilty and the charges of misconduct of molesting the girls in the train have been established and proved, thereafter, the respective petitioners have been terminated from services. We see no reason to interfere with the same. Even otherwise there is a huge delay of 1725 days in preferring the Special Leave Petition. The Special Leave Petition is dismissed on the ground of delay as well as on merits. Pending applications shall stand disposed of.
