We are not inclined to interfere in the matter.

However, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the observation in paragraph '7' is prejudicial to the interest of the petitioner inasmuch as if the petitioner attempts to seek regular bail the said observation would come in the way of the petitioner.

In the circumstances, while we are not interfering in the matter, we reserve liberty to the petitioner to seek regular bail. The observation in paragraph '7' is restricted to only the dismissal of the petition seeking anticipatory bail and the therefore, if an application or a petition is filed for seeking regular bail, the same shall be considered on its own merits.

The special leave petition is, hence, dismissed.
