**ORDER**

1. Read the Office Report dated 20<sup>th</sup> May, 2024.
2. None appears for the respondent-husband despite service.
3. This is a petition under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908. The petitioner-wife seeks transfer of proceedings instituted by the respondent-husband under section Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, being Family Main Case No. 489 of 2023 titled 'Deendayal V. Srimati Pooja' pending in the Family Court, Bikaner, Rajasthan to the Court of the Principal Family Judge at Ahmedabad, Gujarat.
4. We have heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner-wife and perused the averments made in the petition. Since the respondent-husband has not put in an appearance and has also not filed any counter affidavit to the petition, the averments made therein are deemed to have been admitted by him.
5. Even otherwise, we are of the view that the prayer for transfer ought to be granted in the interest of justice.
6. We, therefore, direct that Family Main Case No. 489 of 2023 titled 'Deendayal V. Srimati Pooja' pending in the Family Court,

Bikaner, Rajasthan shall stand transferred to the Court of the Principal Family Judge at Ahmedabad, Gujarat immediately. The Principal Judge of the Family Court or any other Judge to whom an assignment may be made shall hear and decide the proceedings.

7. To cut short delay, it is directed that the parties may appear before the transferee Court on 09.07.2024. If any of the parties remains unrepresented, appropriate notice shall be issued for appearance and thereafter the transferee Court shall proceed to take the proceedings to their logical conclusion.

8. With the aforesaid directions, the transfer petition stands allowed.

9. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
