Delay condoned.

Petitioner was convicted and sentenced to R.I.for life with fine and default stipulation by the Special Judge (Atrocities), Damoh, Madhya Pradesh, in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 302/120-B of the Indian Penal Code. His appeal is pending in the High Court Court and his application for suspension of sentence and grant of bail was dismissed by the High Court vide the order impugned. Being aggrieved, he approached this Court.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

At this stage, we do not see any occasion to interfere with the order of the High Court, in exercise of our jurisdiction under Article 136 of the Constitution of India.

The petitioner, however, is at liberty to renew the said application before the Court concerned, if his appeal is not decided in another one year.

The present petition is, accordingly, disposed of along with pending application(s), if any.
