O R D E R

The office report indicates that the Ld.counsel for the appellant has already filed the statement of case. What gets revealed from the perusal of the file is that the respondent Nos.1-4 have not filed the statement of case despite notice dated 12.07.2014. Order XIX Rule 32 of the Supreme Court Rules, 2013 provides that if the respondent has entered appearance and does not file a statement of case within the time, as provided in Sub Rule(1) (i.e. 35 days) it shall be presumed that he does not desire to lodge the same.

In view of the rule position cited above no further opportunity for filing the statement of case is warranted to be given to the respondents. Viewed thus, the matter shall be processed for listing before the Hon'ble Court under the rules.
