UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. The High Court has declined to suspend the substantive order of sentence of life imprisonment passed by the Trial Court against the petitioner herein.
2. We take notice of the fact that the petitioner was put to trial in connection with an offence of murder. At the end of

the trial, he stood convicted for the alleged crime and was sentenced to undergo life imprisonment.

3. The petitioner has preferred the Criminal Appeal No. 532 of 2022 in the High Court seeking to challenge the judgment and order of conviction passed by the Trial Court.

4. Taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner is undergoing sentence past seven years and three months and the criminal appeal is of the year 2022, we are of the view that we should request the High Court to take up the appeal for final hearing at the earliest.

5. Let the appeal be heard and disposed of within a period of six months from today. The disposal of the Criminal Appeal No. 532 shall be reported to this Court.

6. List the matter after six months for compliance of this order.
