UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. We are informed by Mr. Tushar Mehta, learned Solicitor General appearing on behalf of the petitioners and Mr. Raju Ramachandran,

learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent that the Writ Appeal is pending before the Division Bench of the High Court which is in fact filed against the order dated 24.12.2025.

3. This Court by order dated 09.03.2026 while issuing notice against the order dated 24.12.2025, also granted an interim order of stay pending disposal of the Special Leave Petition.

4. Having heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties, we are of the opinion that the interest of justice will be subserved if we continue the interim order of stay of the directions of the learned Single Judge till Division Bench takes up and dispose of the Writ Appeal. Ordered accordingly.

5. We also request the Division Bench of the High Court to take up and dispose of the Writ Appeals expeditiously.

6. We make it clear that we have not expressed any opinion on the merits of the matter.

7. With these observations, the Special Leave Petitions stand disposed of.
