O R D E R

1. The petitioner – wife has filed this Transfer Petition seeking transfer of **Matrimonial Case No. 228 of 2024** titled as “**Subeshwar Mishra Vs. Richa Vatsa**” from the Family Court at Darbhanga, Bihar to the Family Court at Tis Hazari Courts, New Delhi.
2. Heard learned counsel for the parties at length.
3. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the hardships being faced by the petitioner to attend the proceedings at Darbhanga, Bihar, we are of the view that the matter is liable to be transferred.
4. Accordingly, this Transfer Petition is allowed and the subject-case is hereby transferred to the Family Court at Tis Hazari Courts, New Delhi.
5. After the matter is transferred to the Family Court at New Delhi, the concerned Court will give fresh notice to all

the parties by fixing a date and the aforesaid matter shall proceed before the said Court from the stage it was left at the Family Court at Darbhanga, Bihar.

6. The respondent is at liberty to move an application before the Transferee Court seeking permission for his presence through virtual mode, which application shall be considered in accordance with law.

7. The records of the case be transferred to the transferee Court forthwith.

8. All pending applications stand disposed of.
