UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Petitioner and co-accused - Gurnam Singh, have been charge-sheeted for committing murder of deceased - Harbilas Singh on 19.10.2024.

2. Eye-witness Gulsher, who is also the informant, informed the police that two masked assailants fired gun shot on the deceased. He also said that he can identify them, if they come in front of him, however, during investigation Test Identification Parade was not conducted.

3. The weapon of offence has been recovered from co-accused Gurnam Singh, and not from the petitioner, who is in jail since 28.10.2024.

4. Considering all relevant aspects of the matter, we are inclined to release the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, we direct that the petitioner be released on bail in connection with FIR No. 0174 dated 20.10.2024 registered at Police Station-Ismailabad, District Kurukshetra, for offence punishable under Sections 103(1), 238(a), 3(5), 49, 61(2), 317(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Sections 25 and 29 of the Arms Act, 1959 on such terms and conditions as may be imposed by the Trial Court, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall continue to co-operate with the trial.

5. However, the observations made in this order shall have no bearing on the trial.

6. Accordingly, the Special Leave Petition stands disposed of.

7. Pending applications(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.

O R D E R
