1. Leave granted.
2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. This appeal arises from an order dated 17.12.2025 passed by the High Court of Uttarakhand rejecting the regular bail prayer of the appellant in connection with FIR No. RC0072024(A)0002, registered at P.S. CBI SPE, Dehradun.
4. Having regard to the maximum sentence which could be awarded to the appellant under the provision in which he is being tried as also that the appellant by now has suffered over two years of incarceration

pending trial, we are of the view that the appellant is entitled to be released on bail at this stage.

5. Accordingly, the appeal is allowed. The order passed by the High Court rejecting the regular bail prayer of the appellant is set aside.

6. The appellant shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the trial court may deem fit to impose in the facts and circumstances of the case.

7. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
