UPON hearing the counsel, the Court made the following
O R D E R

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Attorney General for India, appearing for the Union of India, we are of the opinion that the grievance of the petitioner, Doniyar Vildanov, who has been acquitted by this Court, *vide* judgment dated 30.01.2026 passed in Criminal Appeal No. 527/2026, requires to be redressed.

In the meanwhile, the authorities shall make arrangements forthwith to transfer the petitioner, Doniyar Vildanov, from Maharajganj Detention Centre/Camp/Police Barrack, Uttar Pradesh, to

Lampur Detention Centre/Lampur Seva Sadan located in Narela, North-West Delhi, which is under the control of the Foreigners Regional Registration Office (FRR0) or any other detention centre in Delhi, which is under the control of the authorities.

Learned Attorney General states that necessary measures would be initiated by the Ministries concerned to secure issuance/re-issuance of a valid passport to the petitioner's, as his existing Passport expired during the period of his incarceration.
