On a pointed query as to why, in the first instance, the petitioner had not approached the High Court for appropriate directions/orders, Mr. Dushyant A. Dave, learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioner, submits that as per his instructions the Bench headed by the Chief Justice of the High Court is not holding the2/-

Court till 17th of April, 2011. In view of the information so furnished, we direct that on petitioner's filing appropriate application before the High Court within two days from today,

the said application shall be taken up for consideration as expeditiously as practicable, irrespective of the fact whether the Hon'ble Chief Justice is holding the Court or not.

At this juncture, it is stated by learned counsel appearing for the State that according to his instructions encroachment on the subject land has since been removed and the Government land has been reclaimed. Though the said fact is disputed by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, but without going into the merits of the said controversy, we direct that till the petitioner's application is taken up for consideration, status quo in regard to the nature, title and possession of the existing structures and the land shall be maintained.

Permission to file special leave petition is declined accordingly.
