UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. Having heard learned counsel for the parties, we see no error in the decision of the High Court relegating the petitioner to the Himachal Pradesh State Regulatory Commission for determination of the disputes.

3. As the petitioner approaches the Regulatory Commission, the interim measure between the parties shall continue for a period till the Regulatory Commission would consider it necessary to modify the said orders.

4. Needless to say that the Commission will hear both the parties before varying the existing interim order. The Commission shall not be influenced by the observations, if any, made by the learned Single Judge as well as the Division Bench of the High Court. All contentions are left open for the parties to raise and contested before the Commission.

5. With these observations, the Special Leave Petition stands disposed of.
