If the petitioners file fresh review petitions and make application for impleadment of the builders and developers within two weeks, then the High Court is expected to thoroughly consider the issue whether the acquisition was, in fact, for a public purpose or for the benefit of private builders and developers. The High Court may also consider the desirability of ordering thorough enquiry into the collaboration agreements entered by the builders/developers with the landowners and the change of land use sanctioned by the State Government/Competent Authority after 2.6.2009, i.e. the date on which Section 4(1) Notification was issued.

We also direct that till the passing of fresh order by the High Court on the review petitions, the petitioners shall not be dispossessed from their land.

The special leave petitions are disposed of in the manner indicated above.

It is needless to say that if the fresh review petitions are dismissed by the High Court, then the petitioners shall be entitled to approach this Court.

Copy of the order be given dasti.

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SLP(C)No..../2012 (CC No.8015)

This petition is directed against order dated 31.05.2011 passed by the Division Bench of the Punjab & Haryana High Court whereby the writ petition of the petitioners was dismissed on the ground of non-disclosure of a material fact.

After making some submissions, Shri Gagan Gupta, learned counsel for the petitioners made a request that his clients may be permitted to withdraw the special leave petition with liberty to make a representation to the High Powered Committee as is being done by other landowners pursuant to the order passed by the High Court in other cases.

The request of the learned counsel is accepted and the special leave petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty in

terms of the prayer made.
