UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

When the matter is taken up, it is submitted by Mr. Udayaditya Banerjee, learned counsel appearing for the caveator, that while the present special leave petitions arise out of an interim order dated 14th March, 2013, passed by the Calcutta High Court, the main matter has itself been heard and judgment has been reserved. It has also been pointed out by him that in another connected S.L.P. (C) No.9298 of 2013, an order of status quo was passed on 26th February, 2013, and the same is subsisting.

Having regard to the above, we see no reason to interfere in the matter and the special leave petitions are dismissed, but this will not prevent the petitioner from questioning the final order, that is to be passed in the pending appeal, in the Calcutta High Court.

The observations made in the impugned order, shall be treated to be for the purposes of the interim order only.
