Therefore, Matrimonial Case No. 02/2026 titled "*Sandeep Negi Vs. Sunidhi Negi*" pending before the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, District Bageshwar, Uttarakhand is ordered to be transferred to the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, District Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh.

5. Records of the case should immediately be transferred to the transferee court.

6. The parties may explore the possibility of settlement through Mediation. The transferee court would obtain the desire and wishes of the parties and proceed accordingly in this regard.

7. The parties are at liberty initially to appear through virtual mode. If such request is made, the concerned court may favourably consider the same and thereafter, if need be, the parties can be asked to appear through

physical mode.

8. The Transfer Petition is allowed accordingly.

9. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
