UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. It is not in dispute that the petitioners' co-accused (Saif Ali, Roshan Kumar Thakur and Divy Chandrawanshi) have been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 01.12.2025 and 16.02.2026 passed in SLP(Crl.) Nos. 16447/2025, 17655/2026 and 1839/2026, respectively.
2. For the reasons assigned in those orders and without expressing any opinion on the merits, the prayer for bail is allowed. The petitioners are directed to be released on bail on the same terms and conditions. The petitioners shall regularly appear before the Trial Court, and in case they are found to be absent, it shall be taken as a misuse

of the concession of bail.

3. The Special Leave Petitions are, accordingly, disposed of. Pending applications, if any, also stand closed.
