UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. This application has been filed by the petitioner to waive / suitably modify of the condition imposed by this Court on

17.12.2025 whereunder petitioner has been directed to mark his attendance between 11:00 a.m. to 01:00 p.m. before the jurisdictional Investigating Officer every week till the conclusion of the trial and seeks permission of marking attendance before the trial court only as he is residing 1500 kms away from the jurisdictional Investigating Officer and is taking care of his son who is suffering from autism.

3. Having regard to these facts, we are of the considered view that the interest of justice would be protected if the said condition is modified as under:

(a) The petitioner shall appear before the SHO of the jurisdictional Police Station where the petitioner resides and mark his attendance once a week, i.e., on 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of every month;

(b) The petitioner shall also mark his attendance before the Investigating Officer, Faridabad on the dates of hearing before the trial court.
