UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

1. Permission to file Special Leave Petitions is granted.
2. Heard learned senior counsel for the parties at considerable length.
3. The interlocutory orders under challenge passed by the High Court of Delhi have arisen out of W.P. (Crl.) No. 2/2026 and various applications moved therein.

4. The above-stated writ petition is now listed on 21.04.2026 before Justice Anup Jairam Bhambhani, as per the roster.

5. We find that the petitioners before us are also necessary and proper parties to be heard by the High Court. Consequently, their application(s) for impleadment shall be deemed to have been allowed.

6. Since the main case is still pending before the High Court, we do not express any opinion on the merits, allegations or cross-allegations made by the parties. All that we deem appropriate is to request the learned Judge to make an endeavour to take up the main case on the date fixed for final disposal. Learned senior counsel for the parties have assured that full cooperation shall be extended to the learned Judge.

7. Hon'ble Chief Justice of the High Court shall also list the interim applications, if any, which have been filed in the main case before Justice Anup Jairam Bhambhani, as per the roster. Any order on those applications may be passed after hearing both sides.

8. At this stage, Mr. S.V. Raju, learned ASG representing the Directorate of Enforcement (ED) has suggested reappointment of a former Judge of this Court as the monitoring authority. We do not express any opinion in relation thereto and leave it open to the ED to make such prayer before the High Court.

9. The Special Leave Petitions stand disposed of with pending application(s), if any.
