- 1.That the petitioner shall make himself available before the investigating agency as and when
required;
- 2.That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any perso
n acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him for disclosing such facts to the
Court or to any police officer; and
- 3.That he shall not leave the country without previous permission of this Court.
