O R D E R

We have heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

We do not find any ground to interfere with the impugned order passed by the High Court only on the premise that the petitioner's application for substitution is still pending consideration before the DRT in MA No.120/2019 in OA No.767/2017. Certainly, arguments have been heard in the execution proceedings pertaining to the attachment of the subject property.

We only direct the DRT, Chandigarh and the Jurisdictional

Civil Court to conclude the aforesaid proceedings within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Based upon the aforesaid order, liberty is given to the petitioner to work out the remedy in the manner known to law, in which case, the impugned order will not stand in the way of the petitioner.

With the aforesaid observations, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of, accordingly.
