O R D E R

1. Issue notice, returnable on 13th April, 2026.
2. Mr. Astik Gupta, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the State of Madhya Pradesh.
3. Respondent-State of Madhya Pradesh may file its counter affidavit at least 48 hours prior to the returnable date. Such affidavit ought to include, *inter alia*, the following:

- (i) particulars of chargesheet, if filed;
- (ii) number of witnesses proposed to be examined by the prosecution;
- (iii) whether charge has been framed or not;
- (iv) if the charge has not been framed, the reason therefor;
- (v) if the trial has commenced, the number of witnesses examined;
- (vi) criminal antecedents of the petitioner;
- (vii) whether any co-accused is enlarged on bail; and
- (viii) any other information relevant for a decision on the special leave petition.
