In the facts and circumstances of the case, we are of the opinion that the appellants should be released on anticipatory bail in the event of they being arrested. Therefore, we direct the trial court or the arresting authority, as the case may be, to release the appellants on bail on their furnishing self bond in the sum of Rs.10,000/- with one surety for the like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting authority/trial court as the case may be.

The appellants shall abide by the conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) of the Cr.PC.
