This appeal has been filed against the impugned judgment and order dated 17.3.2003 of National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, New Delhi. The National Commission has refused to condone the delay of only 56 days in filing the Revision Petition. In our opinion the National Consumer

Disputes Redressal Commission should have taken a liberal view and should have condoned the delay. This appeal is hence allowed, the impugned order is set aside and matter is remanded back to the National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, New Delhi to hear the matter on merits expeditiously.

We are not expressing any opinion as to whether there is any period of limitation in filing a revision under section 21 as there is in section 23. The Civil Appeal is allowed.
