UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. Petitioner has allegedly forged his date of birth in his matriculation certificate and used that certificate to secure appointment in the Indian Reserve Battalion as a

Constable, in the year 2002.

2. The present FIR was lodged on 26.08.2025 i.e. after 23 years of the occurrence of the alleged incident.

3. Learned State Counsel informs that upon completion of the departmental enquiry, petitioner has already been terminated from the service; and the fact of forging of date of birth certificate has been established in the departmental enquiry.

4. Be that as it may, considering that the petitioner has already been granted interim protection and the delay in lodging the FIR, we are inclined to make absolute the interim order dated 26.02.2026. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be enlarged on bail in connection with FIR No. 195/2025 registered at Police Station-Badhra, District Charkhi Dadri, for offence punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 on such terms and conditions as may be imposed by the Trial Court, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall continue to co-operate with the trial/ investigation.

5. Accordingly, the Special Leave Petition stands disposed of.

6. Pending applications(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
