Leave granted.

The impugned order granted an interim relief to the writ petitioner, the life of which was to come to an end in the first week of July, 2003. On 16.6.2003, the operation of the impugned order passed by the High Court was directed to be stayed and therefore the impugned order has not come into operation. Now the life of impugned order passed by the High Court is itself over. This appeal is rendered infructuous and no adjudication on merits is required.

However, we request the High Court to hear the writ petition itself as it was to come up in the first week of July, 2003 and it is stated at the Bar that the matter has not been listed and not heard and decided in spite of the order dated 22.5.2003 passed by the High Court.
