As per the orders impugned bail has been granted to the
respondents on conditions enumerated in the order itself.
Mr.Harish N. Salve, learned Solicitor General of India
appearing for the State of Gujarat submitted that those
conditions are quite sufficient particularly when investigation
has been completed and charge-sheets have been laid before the
court. But he expressed apprehension that as the accused are

persons of high influence they may adopt dilatory tactics for
prolonging the trials. We make it clear that if the
prosecuting agency feels that any of the accused resorts to
such tactics it is open to them to move for cancellation of the
bail and any such move made will be disposed of by the trial
court without much delay. We hope that this rider is

sufficient to take care of the apprehensions expressed by the learned Solicitor General of India. The committal courts shall commit the cases as expeditiously as possible, so that, trial court can proceed further without delay. With these observations these Special Leave Petitions are disposed of.
