O R D E R

The special leave petition is dismissed. However, the time for depositing amount of Rs. 22.31 lakhs is extended subject to the condition of the petitioner depositing Rs. 10 lakhs with the Recovery Officer, Debt Recovery Tribunal, Jaipur within a period of two weeks from today and the balance amount within a period of four weeks thereafter. In case of such deposit, it shall be deemed that there was sufficient compliance with the order of the High Court.

There shall not be dispossession in case the amount is deposited in the manner aforesaid. In case of default in complying with the conditions as to deposit, the petitioner can be dispossessed.
