Petitioner-wife has moved this petition under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure for transfer of Case No. 1-S/3 of 2004 filed by the respondent-husband under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled Ashok Kumar vs. Lakhwinder Kaur pending before the District Judge, Shimla to the Court of District Judge, Nawanshahar(Punjab).
