O R D E R

1. The order impugned in the present special leave petition arising from the order of the learned Single Judge rendered in WP No.28643/2025, which is an appealable order, namely, the same can be challenged in a writ appeal as provided under The Karnataka High Court Act, 1961. Hence, reserving liberty to the petitioner to approach the appellate court, the present special leave petition stands dismissed.

2. It is made clear that, in the event of an intra-court appeal being filed within two weeks from today, the period spent from the date of filing of this petition till the filing of appeal or two weeks whichever earlier shall stand excluded for the purposes of computation of limitation, and even otherwise, the petitioner can take recourse to Section 14 of the Limitation Act, 1963, in the event of the Registry raising any objection with regard to the issue of limitation. In the event such an appeal being filed, we request the High Court to expeditiously consider the same in the teeth of the selection to the post being conducted in a time bound manner by the respondents.
