No.26027/1999 which arose out of an interim order in arbitration proceedings. High Court made an order in the said Writ Petition on 14.2.2000. Against that order of the High Court, the present special leave petition has been filed by the petitioner. Learned counsel for respondent No.4 submits that since arbitration proceedings now stand withdrawn, Writ Petition (C) No.26027/1999 pending in the High Court does not survive further consideration as the same has been rendered infructuous.
