UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

We have heard learned counsel for the petitioners at
length.

Learned counsel has pointed out the land of which the
petitioners seek re-conveyance is actually lying unused. Even,
the impugned order of the High Court clearly records that there
is no possession taken by the Board in terms of the Regulation 5
of the Karnataka Industrial Area Development Regulation 69.

Learned counsel has further submitted that in view of the
opinion rendered by the Special Deputy Commissioner regarding re-
conveyance of the land, the petitioners had legitimate
expectation that the same should be re-conveyed to the land
owners. In our opinion, if that be the case, the petitioners
ought to approach the Authority for reconsideration of the
matter. If a representation is made by the petitioners seeking
re-conveyance of the acquired land within a period of one month,
the plea shall be considered by the Board without being
influenced by the impugned order made by the High Court.

In view of the aforesaid, learned counsel seeks permission

to withdraw the special leave petition. Ordered accordingly.
