UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. This petition impugns Condition (c) imposed in the anticipatory bail granting order dated 10.02.2026 passed by the Madurai Bench of Madras High Court in Criminal O.P

(M.D.) No. 1176/2026. Condition (c) reads as under:

“(c) In two adjudication proceedings it is clearly recorded that the defacto complainant is in administration as on date, the other group shall not interfere in the administration.”

2. The learned counsel for petitioner submits that there is a serious dispute *qua* administration of the institution(s) and imposition of such Condition places a restriction on petitioner's right to make a lawful claim *qua* administration of the institution(s).

3. Be that as it may, we deem it appropriate to dispose of this special leave petition by observing that the aforesaid Condition (C) shall not come in the way of the petitioner to take recourse to such legal remedies as may be available to him in law for staking a claim *qua* administration

of the institution(s) and to pursue litigation already pending in that regard.

4. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand dispose of.
