The High Court directed that the appellant is not entitled to recover a sum of Rs. 15,387/-, as stated in Official Memorandum dated 24th March, 1994. In reaching this conclusion the High Court applied the principle laid down by this Court in various decisions, and hence we do not find any useful purpose will be served by re-examining the matter. The learned counsel for the appellant submitted that in the light of the Circular dated 23.7.1965 as amended by Memo dated 30.5.1966, which is stated not to have been taken into consideration by the High Court the matter may need reconsideration. But this is not a fit case for our interference. Hence, we decline to interfere with the order.

The appeals stand dismissed.
