UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. Mr. Shekhar Mehla, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has absolutely no role in the relationship, if any, between his brother - *Sukhwinder Singh* and the informant. The only aspect attributed to him is that a sum of Rupees Nine Lakhs was transferred from the account of the informant to his account at the instruction of his

brother. According to learned counsel, the said amount has also been paid back to the brother. He is completely oblivious about any relationship that his brother may have had with the informant. Learned counsel submits that continuation of prosecution'case against the petitioner would be an abuse of process of law.

3. Issue notice, returnable on 18<sup>th</sup> May, 2026.

4. In the meantime, further proceedings in the case bearing No.SC/81/2025 (arising out of FIR No.81/2024 dated 26.09.2024 registered with Police Station Garhdiwal, District Hoshiarpur, Punjab), pending in the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Fast Track Special Court, Hoshiarpur, Punjab, shall remain stayed, insofar as the petitioner is concerned.
