O R D E R

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the Division Bench of the High Court dismissed the Writ Appeal on a factually incorrect ground that petitioner preferred the Writ Appeal after the directions issued by the Single Judge were acted upon by the Collector.

2. According to learned counsel, the Collector passed the order, as directed by learned Single Judge, on 30.06.2025 whereas, the

petitioner has already preferred the Writ Appeal in December, 2024.

3. On merits, it is argued that the petitioner has undergone a regular courses in *Purv Madhima Improvement Exam* and Computer Application Programme simultaneously which is permissible and on that score, 50 marks for having computer qualification cannot be withdrawn. If that 50 marks are added to petitioner's score, she would secure 111.11 marks, which is higher than the respondent's total marks, i.e. 102.89 marks.

4. Issue notice, returnable on 19.05.2026.

5. In the meanwhile, operation and effect of the impugned order, shall remain stayed.
