O R D E R

1. Heard learned senior counsel appearing for the

petitioner.

2. Delay condoned.

3. The Execution Petition No.126 of 2016 is pending before the Additional Civil Judge and Metropolitan Magistrate No.2, Jaipur.

4. The High Court by an order dated 07.02.2020 had directed the executing court to decide the aforesaid execution petition expeditiously but not later than six months from the date of receipt of the order of the Court.

5. Since February, 2020 several extensions have been granted by the High Court but still the execution petition continues to remain pending.

6. In the facts and circumstances of the case, we direct the Executing Court to complete the execution proceedings and to bring it to a logical end most expeditiously preferably within a period of three months from today provided there is no legal impediment in proceeding with it and report compliance to this Court.

7. The Special Leave Petition stands disposed of accordingly. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
