**ORDER**

1. Leave granted.
2. The Director, All India Institute of Medical Sciences<sup>1</sup>, new Delhi has submitted individual reports prepared by the Medical Board upon due examination of the three appellants. Only the appellant no.1, viz. Bhosale Akash Gajanan, has been found not to suffer from any visionary defect and is, therefore, medically fit for appointment in the Central Industrial Security Force<sup>2</sup>. The other two appellants, unfortunately, have been found to suffer from visionary defects rendering them disqualified for appointment.
3. We appreciate the efforts of the Director, AIIMS and the Medical Board to comply with this Court's order within such a short time.
4. The appeal, insofar as the appellant no.1 is concerned,

succeeds. The impugned order of the Division Bench of the High Court on his writ petition stands set aside. However, dismissal of the writ petition of the other two appellants is upheld.

5. Appellant no.1, viz. Bhosale Akash Gajanan, shall present himself before the competent authority of the CISF within a period of a fortnight from date with a copy of this order whereafter he may be offered appointment and/or enrolled as a member of the CISF subject to compliance with all other formalities including successful completion of training.

6. Because of delay not attributable to the appellant no.1, he may lose out on seniority. It is made clear that the appellant no.1 upon his appointment/enrolment shall be entitled to notional seniority from the date others in his batch were appointed/enrolled, as per rules. However, he shall not be entitled for any back wages for the said period.

7. The appeals stand disposed of accordingly.

8. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
