O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. The instant application has been filed seeking modification of the order dated 13.01.2026, whereby the main appeals arising against an interim order were disposed of.
3. It is stated by learned counsel for the applicant(s) that about 17 appeals re: determination of compensation for the acquired land are pending before the High Court, in which this Court has made an interim arrangement regarding the deposit of 50% of the enhanced compensation amount with the Executing Court, and that amount has been directed to be kept in a nationalised bank in FDR.
4. Owing to the nature of relief sought by the applicant(s),

we request the High Court to take up all 17 appeals, on an out-of-turn basis, and make an endeavour to decide the same, preferably within a period of four months.
