UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Heard Mr. Amit Pawan, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr. Anshul Narayan, learned counsel for the respondent-State.
2. When the matter came up before this Court on 23.03.2026, while dismissing the Special Leave Petition against petitioner No.3 (Dharmendra Kumar), petitioner No.4 (Dhananjay Kumar) and petitioner No.5 (Gopal Yadav), we granted interim protection

to petitioner Nos.1 (Sanyoga Devi @ Sanyoga Kumari) and petitioner No.2 (Sanju Kumari).

3. Today, we have been taken through the contents of the First Information Report lodged by the *de-facto* complainant as well as cross case lodged by the petitioners herein. We have also seen injury report. Mr. Anshul Narayan, learned counsel for the State points out that there is one antecedent against petitioner no.1, however, further details are not forthcoming.

4. Mr. Amit Pawan, learned counsel for the petitioners states that it was an incident of the same day and involved offence under Section 117(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (Section 325 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860), for which she was on bail.

5. Considering the overall facts and circumstances of the present case and the presence of case and case in counter, we are inclined to confirm the order made by us on 23.03.2026, granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner Nos.1 and 2.

6. The petitioners shall continue to cooperate in the investigation.

7. The Special Leave Petition is disposed of in the above terms.

8. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
