Heard learned counsel for the parties.
Leave granted.

This petition has been filed against the impugned judgment and order dated 5.1.2012, passed by the High Court of Punjab & Haryana at Chandigarh in Criminal Appeal No. 1808 of 2010 by which the High Court has allowed the appeal partly setting aside the conviction of the appellant under Section 489B IPC as well as the sentence for a period of 7 years and a fine of Rs.2000/- but maintained the conviction and sentence of 3 years and a fine of Rs.1000/- under Section 489C IPC. The appellant has already served about 2 years.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, the sentence of the appellant is reduced to the period already undergone. He shall be released forthwith in Misc. Sessions Case No. 15 of 2010 in connection with FIR NO. 571 dated 07.11.2006 registered at P.S. Chandni Bagh Panipat, Haryana if not required in any other case.

The criminal appeal is disposed of.
